WHAT IS A 940?



- **940 Also Known As Warehouse Shipping Order**

It acts as a formal request for shipment of goods from a remote warehouse to a buyer's location

- **Who Uses the 940**

Suppliers

Distributors

- **What is the Purpose of the 940**

Communicates shipping requests from a seller to a warehouse

It contains information about order identification, such as, carrier details and line-item details

BENEFITS OF THE 940 AND HOW THEY WORK

- **Benefits**

- Improved shipping and receiving planning

- Increase order-processing speed

- Eliminates errors associated with manual data entry

- Reduced storage costs

- Reduced inventory cost and accurate inventory forecasts

- **How a 940 Works**

- Sent by the Seller to a Warehouse

- Notifies the Warehouse of an order that needs shipped

WHAT IS A 945?



- **945 Also Known As Warehouse Shipping Advice**

Transaction sent mainly by a third-party logistics provider (3PL) or remote warehouse to their client

- **Who Uses the 945**

Suppliers

Distributors

- **What is the Purpose of the 945**

It confirms a Shipment has taken place

BENEFITS OF THE 945 AND HOW THEY WORK

- **Benefits**

Report a reason for Changes

ex. Shipping Date, Out of Stock Items, or Item Substitution

Reduces manual data entry

Buyers, sellers, and warehouses have better visibility on shipping details

Automating the process improves the efficiency and accuracy of the information and avoids shipping errors

- **How a 945 Works**

Sent by the Warehouse to the Seller

Seller creates an ASN from the information in the 945 to send to partner
