

Episode 5: Raw EDI Data, Part 3 - EDIFACT (Q&A)		
QUESTIONS AND ANSWERS		
Can multiple transactions appear within a single UNH/UNT? Or do you need a UNH/UNT for each transaction?	You need one for each transaction.	
Does True Commerce use only EDIFACT, X12 or any other formats?	EDIFACT and Tradacoms are used in the UK for EDI messages. X12 messages are becoming more prominent in the UK as well.	
Where do we go within TrueCommerce Foundry to view Raw EDI data?	Within Foundry, select Transaction Manager from the primary navigation menu. Click on a transaction within the Inbox, for example, then select View Raw EDI from the drop-down from the action bar. Additionally, if you double-click on a transaction to open its Transaction Details page, you can then select the EDI tab to view the categorized EDI details.	
How does one know which EDIFACT Directory is in use? Referencing the TRUUGO website, how do you make that determination? Is that in the header transaction?	TRUUGO has many directories for all of the different message types. The directory would be contained within the message itself; for example, there would be a D968 text within the header so it would be within the UNH segments. They would indicate which directory needs to be checked (D.968). TRUUGO have a free online directory that contains the full breakdown of each EDIFACT format and message type. For more information, click here .	
Does the data in TrueCommerce show only one UNH per entry?	For each separate message or order there will be a UNH (header) for one PO, then it would end with a UNT (trailer), and then a new PO would start with a new UNH statement.	
Is the Tradacoms standard the same as EDIFACT but primarily for the UK?	No, they are completely different. The EDIFACT format is more similar to the X12 (which is used primarily in the U.S.) message than a Tradacoms message.	
Would the BGM, 220 code, and 9 code be indicated in EDI documentation? In other words, would those details need to be found within the EDI documentation to read or code correctly?	Yes. These are integral data elements indicating that it is an original order (in this case, the 220 code), so they would be mandatory fields.	
Can interpretation of PO4 segment differ between retailers?	This is in reference to an X12 segment, not EDIFACT.	



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(For example, PO4 2*2 could be 2 inners of 2, and it could also mean master of 2 and inner of 2)
